# **YOUNG MAJORS**

- Kym and Colin reported on the 2023 Young Majors program, a partnership with MTIR (Major Taylor Iron Riders).
- There is no formal agreement between the clubs at this point.
- The season starts on September 16 and runs for 6 weeks. Orientation will be held September 9
- Young Majors now owns some long term assets a bike fleet will need to be stored and maintained. There are also helmets, water bottles, and bottle cages.
- Participants get a free USA Cycling membership, and receive insurance via this membership. Participants also sign up for a NYCC junior membership.
- The program is supported by BGDB (volunteers), BroSis (some funds, participant recruiting), Recycle-a-Bicycle, Bike NY, USA Cycling (free helmets), Kids Ride Club (participants, marketing help, volunteers), DOT (helmets), Steve Vaccaro Law Firm (donate \$\$)
- The board discussed the need to potentially formalize the partnership with Major Taylor Iron Riders in a simple way. The Board recommended requesting Peter Storey assist in drafting some kind of agreement for both parties.
