- D. To Bring "Bring a sunny attitude and money for lunch." In addition, in the Newcomers Ride write-up, we should underscore the minimum requirements we have for cycling equipment: helmet, two water bottles, two spare tubes, air pump, etc.
- E. <u>Bail Out</u> Advise all riders before the start of the rides that if they need to bail for whatever reason, they MUST let one of the ride leaders know.
